COMPETITION DIRECTOR: Rich Trevino

JUDGES: Two judges per event, four events competing at once.

WHO: *Any level 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6 Achievement athlete, OR any level 5 or 6 Placement athlete. (Remember this is an ACHIEVEMENT State Meet). No prior score is required*

ENTRY FEES: **\$50 PER ATHLETE**

NO TEAM COMPETITION FOR LEVELS 2 & 3

Only one company check or money order per club will be accepted. No personal checks.
There will be a \$25 charge for all returned checks.

DEADLINE: Entries must be RECEIVED by November 10, 2008
No entries will be accepted after this date.

SCHEDULE:

A final schedule and map will be posted on the TXUSAG.com website and on <http://www.trevinosgymnastics.com/> -by November 22, 2008.

BAR SETTINGS:

Bar settings may be obtained during the general stretch time prior each session. Coaches, please be prepared to work with each other to help things operate smoothly.

FORMAT:

This competition will follow the USAG Rules and Policies

- The competition will be run in the Capital Cup Format. Any change in format will be sent along with the final schedule.
Level 2 & 3 athletes will compete together in their own separate sessions.
SCORES WILL BE FLASHED FOR ALL LEVELS, INCLUDING LEVELS 2 & 3

AGE GROUPS:

No age groups will apply at this competition

AWARDS:

One portion of the awards system for this competition will vary from the traditional achievement awards format.

In each session, the top 60% of the athletes (by score) on each event will receive a medal.

- Of that 60% on each event:
 - The top 34% will receive GOLD MEDALS.
(Gold Medalist Division)
 - The middle 33% will receive SILVER MEDALS.
(Silver Medalist Division)
 - The bottom 33% will receive BRONZE MEDALS.
(Bronze Medalist Division)

In the All Around 100% of the athletes will receive a medal.

- The top 34% will receive GOLD MEDALS.
(Gold Medalist Division)
- The middle 33% will receive SILVER MEDALS.
(Silver Medalist Division)
- The bottom 33% will receive BRONZE MEDALS.
(Bronze Medalist Division)
- We will also give the traditional achievement ribbons
- No Scores will be announced at the awards ceremony.
- The athletes in each awards division will be announced RANDOMLY, NOT IN RANK ORDER.

Team Format:

- Team awards will be given for each session.
- NO TEAM COMPETITION FOR LEVELS 2 & 3
- Separate team awards for Level 4, 5 & 6.
- Top 3 scores per event (regardless of # of athletes)
- Every paid team entry will receive an award
- Team awards will follow the same percentage format as the individual all around awards

WARM UPS:

Level 4, 5 & 6: Each athlete will receive 1 minute per event.
Level 2 & 3: Each athlete will receive 30 seconds per event.

EQUIPMENT:

All competitive equipment will be Spieth Anderson

- All boards must remain at their assigned event; there will be both Spieth and Stratum Boards available.
- Personal boards will be allowed, but must remain at event for entire session.
- Please alert your athletes that NO chalk will be allowed on the balance beam or vaulting horse.

COACHES MEETING:

There will be a coaches meeting prior to each session to discuss any specific information for each session. All official competition information and rotation sheets will be distributed at that time.

COMPETITION AREA:

Only properly registered*, Safety Certified coaches and competing athletes will be allowed on the floor before, during and after the competition.

****Coaches with competing athletes in that session (with current Pro #'s and Safety Certification) are the only coaches allowed on the competition floor.

At no time will parents be allowed on the competition floor. This applies to before, during, and after the competition. (Including awards) We would appreciate the coach's assistance in helping the parents to understand and comply with this policy.
